Subject: Regarding publishing of map of India in conformity with maps provided by survey of India

In the sub-section (2) of Criminal Law Amendment (Amending) Act, 1990 which states as under:

"whosoever publishes a map of India, which is not in conformity with the maps of India as published by Survey of India, shall be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to six months, or with fine, or with both".

The Higher Educational Institutions are requested to ensure compliance with the aforementioned law. In this regard, a copy of the Criminal Law Amendment (Amending) Act, 1990 Gazette of India dated 17th April, 1990 is enclosed.

THE CRIMINAL LAW AMENDMENT (AMENDING) ACT, 1990

An Act to amend the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1961.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Criminal Law Amendment (Amending) Act, 1990.

2. In the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1961, section 2 shall be renumbered as sub-section (1) thereof, and after sub-section (1) as so renumbered, the following sub-sections shall be inserted, namely:—

22 of 1961.

"(2). Whoever publishes a map of India, which is not in conformity with the maps of India as published by the Survey of India, shall be punishable with imprisonment which may extend to six months, or with fine, or with both.

(3). No court shall take cognizance of an offence punishable under sub-section (2), except on a complaint made by the Government.".
