GOI APPROVAL TO IIMT BUSINESS INCUBATOR

A great breakthrough in the achievements of IIMT !

The University has got approval from the Government of India for its Business Incubator. It is a great opportunity for our students to promote their innovative ideas from incubation to commercialisation. The ideas that get approval would be funded by the Government. IIMT is the only University in complete Western UP zone to get the honour. The main purpose of an incubator is to facilitate the growth of a start-up by providing working space, seed funding, mentoring, training and other benefits. The students can make the most of this golden opportunity and come out with their brilliant ideas and invent services and products of utility to the whole mankind. A worthy project would be granted from Rs.10 lacks to Rs.1 crore by the government. It's now time to turn learning at the University into innovative application to create substantial services and products.

Touchless Sanitizer Dispenser

Full body Sanitization Machine

Another Achievement of IIMT R&D Cell. Team of Research Associate of IIMT has created an automatic sanitizing machine under the direction of Dr. Deepa Sharma, Director of Research and Development Cell, IIMTU. This is another big success of IIM University in research and development filed and shows its continuous and consistent efforts made to develop such a low cost sanitizing machine to protect people from corona infection. This machine will sanitize at a very low cost. Researchers have used ultrasonic sensor in the machine, which will release the required solution after identifying the hand and body of the people. This automatic dispenser can be filled with 5 to 50 liters of solution. The sanitizer has also been made by the research team and fully capable of destroying virus infection. Interestingly, just keeping hands in front of the machine 10 milligrams of foam will be produced, while standing under the machine will produce 20 milliliter spray.

It is also claimed that this will be the first automatic dispenser machine and will cost between Rs. 2000 to Rs.3000 only. Aloe vera and Neem are also added along with 80% alcohol in the sanitizer, which will not harm the skin. Researchers Mr. Sandeep Verma, Mr. Vaibhav Sharma and Mr. Akshay Raj told that the Chancellor of IIMT University, Mr. Yogesh Mohan Gupta inspired to make such sanitizing machine in Corona Time. The team has converted the reverse osmosis (RO) machine into a touchless sanitizer dispenser, which has an ultrasonic sensor for recognizing the people and further releases the solution. Microcontroller and motor pumps are also installed in it. It is quite interesting that a special device has also been installed to sanitize the soles of the feet. For this, one has to stand for few moments in a tray.

Due to the ultrasonic sensor, the dispenser will be effective in every season and under any circumstances as well. The research team said that a very cheap sanitizing dispenser can be used in schools, colleges, institutions, government offices and even in homes. The sanitizing machine will also work entirely on the standards of the World Health Organization.

HERBAL SANITIZER

Accolades to the Pharmacy Department

Adding to the far reaching glory of IIMT University, it was another milestone achieved by the College of Pharmacy to prepare a HAND SANITIZER to fight against Corona Virus and to protect the citizens from the dreaded pandemic. The alcohol based sanitizer is purely herbal that ensures maximum protection from germs. It is absolutely safe for the skin, prevents dryness and keeps it healthy. The sanitizer is much more advantageous than the chemical sanitizers available in the market. The product was initially tested and later circulated in the market. The low cost of the sanitizer along with its medicinal properties created waves through the market. The quality of the sanitizer brought a high demand from the customers. The result being that an order for 1000 bottles was placed in the first week itself.

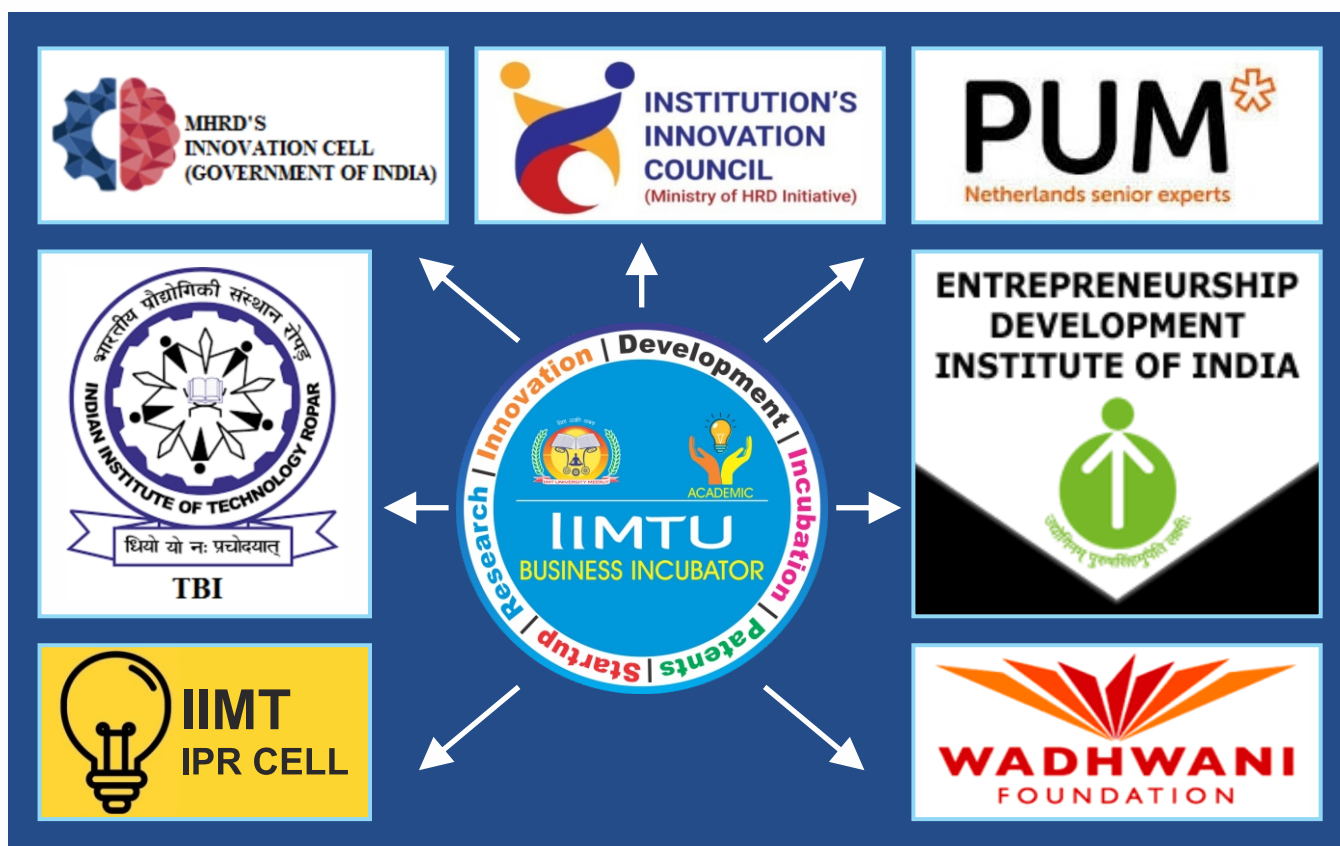
In a very short span of time, the sanitizer was able to call for an order of 2 tonnes from Kuwait. The making of the sanitizer during the times when the world is finding ways to confront the dreaded Corona virus is indeed a laudable attainment for the College of Pharmacy.

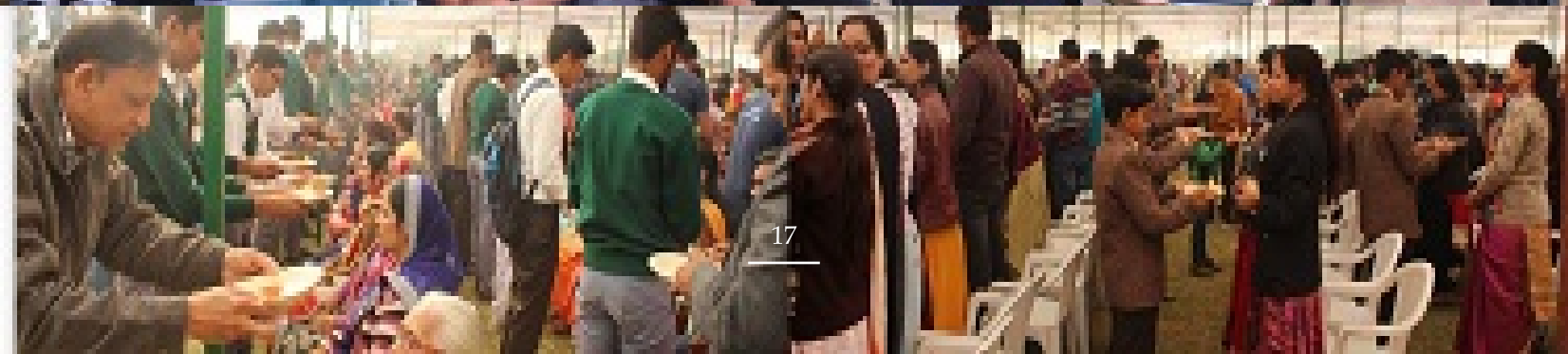

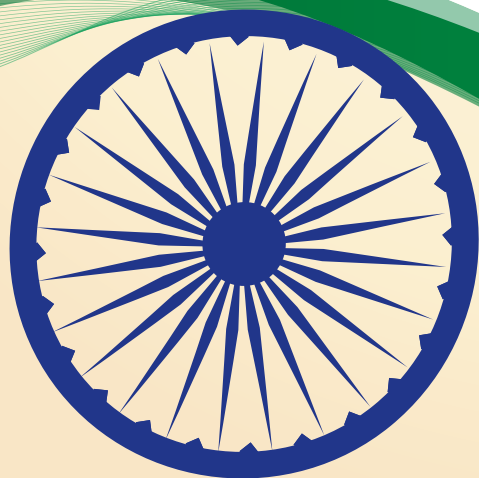

Kalrav "Art of Life" 2020

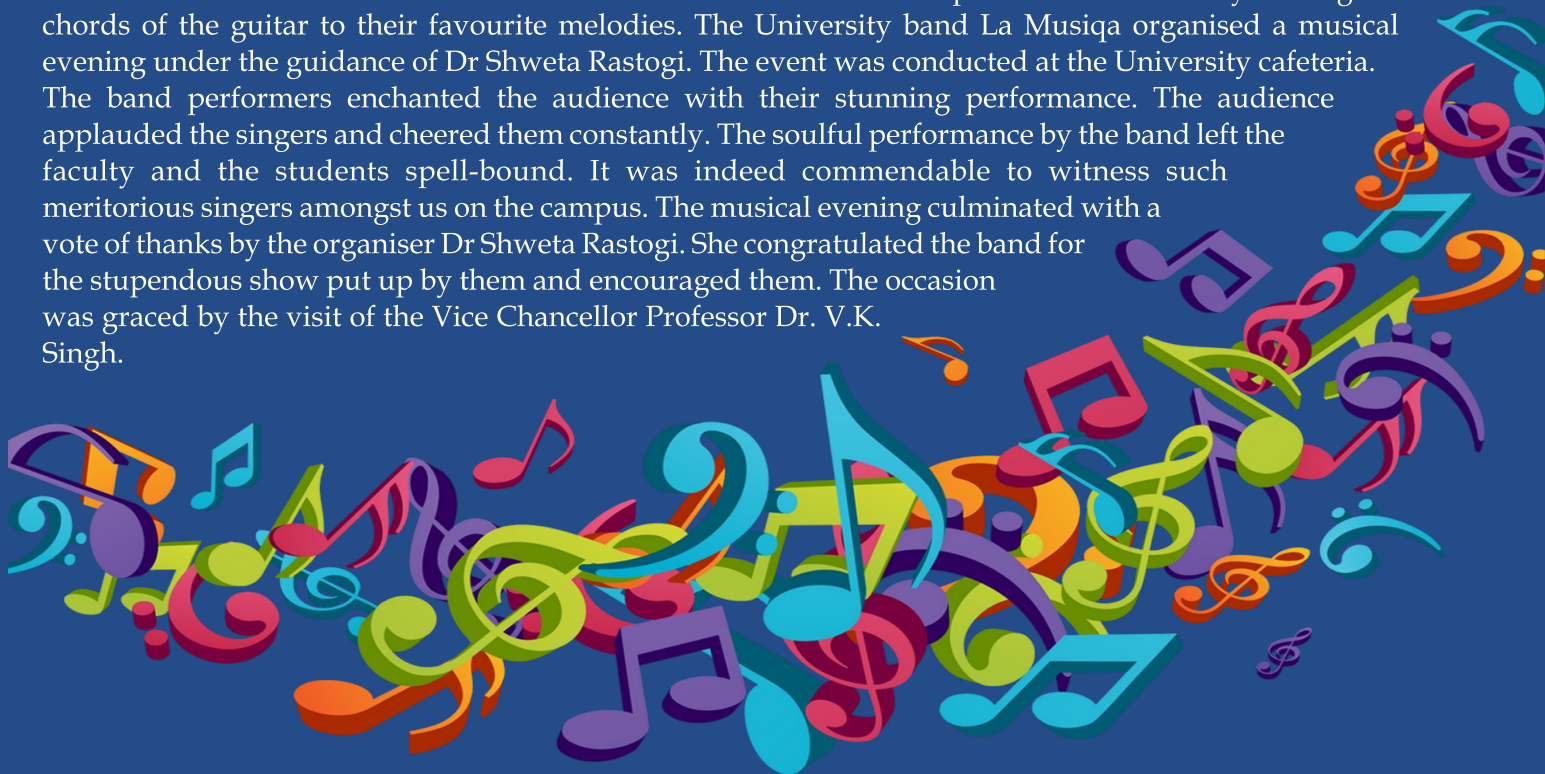
Youth Fest
