# Strengthening The Business Incubator

Then I have been visiting the Incubation Cell for the last two weeks. I have worked upon a couple of projects to initiate a few start-ups.

**IIMTU : How can we further develop our R & D ?**

**Dr Maud :** I would rather call it an Incubation Cell.

We have to have a business model, customers and creation. A lot of creativity is required. Huge participation from the students and faculty. The students need to visit the Incubation Cell on a regular basis to get involved with creation. The cell, although well equipped, must have some WOW effect to make the students interested in visiting the cell.

**IIMTU : What opportunities do we have in your country for IIMTians?**

**Dr Maud :** Yes, we already have a few employees from India working with Netherlands. Only last week, I remember reading an article on Indians working in the Netherlands.

Well, we would like to have your students working in our country but it's not that simple. In case, Netherlands wishes to employ anyone from abroad, it first has to seek approval from the EU. It has to justify that the expertise it is hiring from outside is not available in our country. Then we possibly would be able to hire from India.

**IIMTU : Tell us about your experiences during your visit to India.**

**Dr Maud :** India is a nice country to visit, except for the weather. I have had a chance to visit a few places during my stay here. The people here are very warm and hospitable. Lots of good memories to take home and cherish for years to come.

**IIMTU : Few key points to make the students interested in start-ups.**

**Dr Maud :** They must be taught to be more creative and a lot of effort is required on part of the faculty to make them visit the Incubation Cell more frequently. They must learn to be entrepreneurs. They must be taught to be innovative in their own technical fields.

**IIMTU : What goes into making a student a good entrepreneur?**

**Dr Maud :** A lot of inspiration and innovation. One must learn to initiate a plan, should be creative and be able to develop something new. Yes, definitely a good entrepreneur is the one who is open to ideas from others. He should be able to create as well as find a good customer base.

# Our Projects

## STANDALONE ACCESS CONTROL

The invention of Access Control is another feather in the cap of IIMT. It has been devised by our Research Associate Akshay Raj. Access control is usually one or two small units wired directly onto a door panel to control access to the door. A standalone access control system is an ideal for controlling access whereas a networked system is used when control is required at a central point. It is a setup that controls an individual, who is allowed entry to access a certain resource.

Standalone access control is typically found on doors with low-level security or on smaller buildings with no additional exits. It does not require any additional component. Standalone units can be built with a touch lock system, which means that the user must type in a PIN code (a certain unique combination of numbers) to be granted access. Standalone access controllers can also include proximity readers. When you need to provide a low-security level at an affordable cost, standalone access control units are an effective solution.



## GPS (GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM) VEHICLE SECURITY

GPS Vehicle security system has proved to be a major breakthrough in the long list of achievements at IIMT University, Meerut. Our research and development associates have designed this device to secure your vehicle utilizing vehicle alert framework in addition to GPS beacon. GPS tracker incredibly improves probability to discover Stolen vehicle by helping the police to find and recoup it in a couple of before vehicle is lost until the end of time.

### SANJEEVANI : DRIP MONITOR

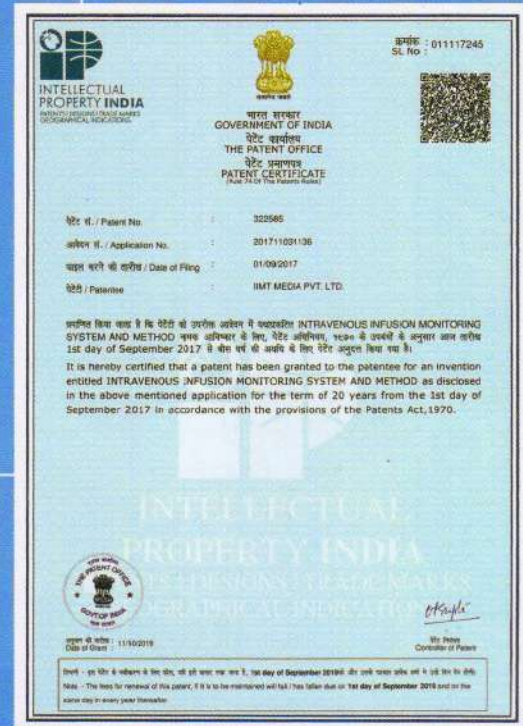
Adding another feather to the cap of IIMT University Research and Development Cell, a big achievement has been made towards humanity.

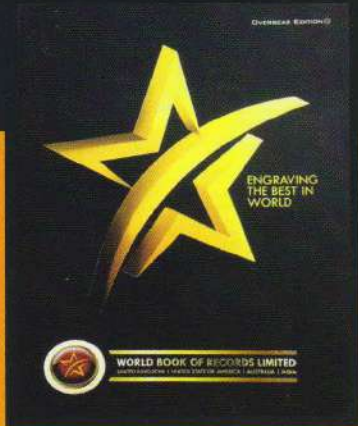

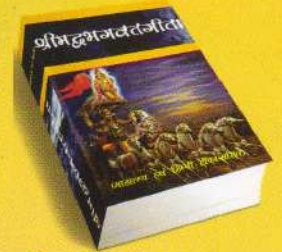

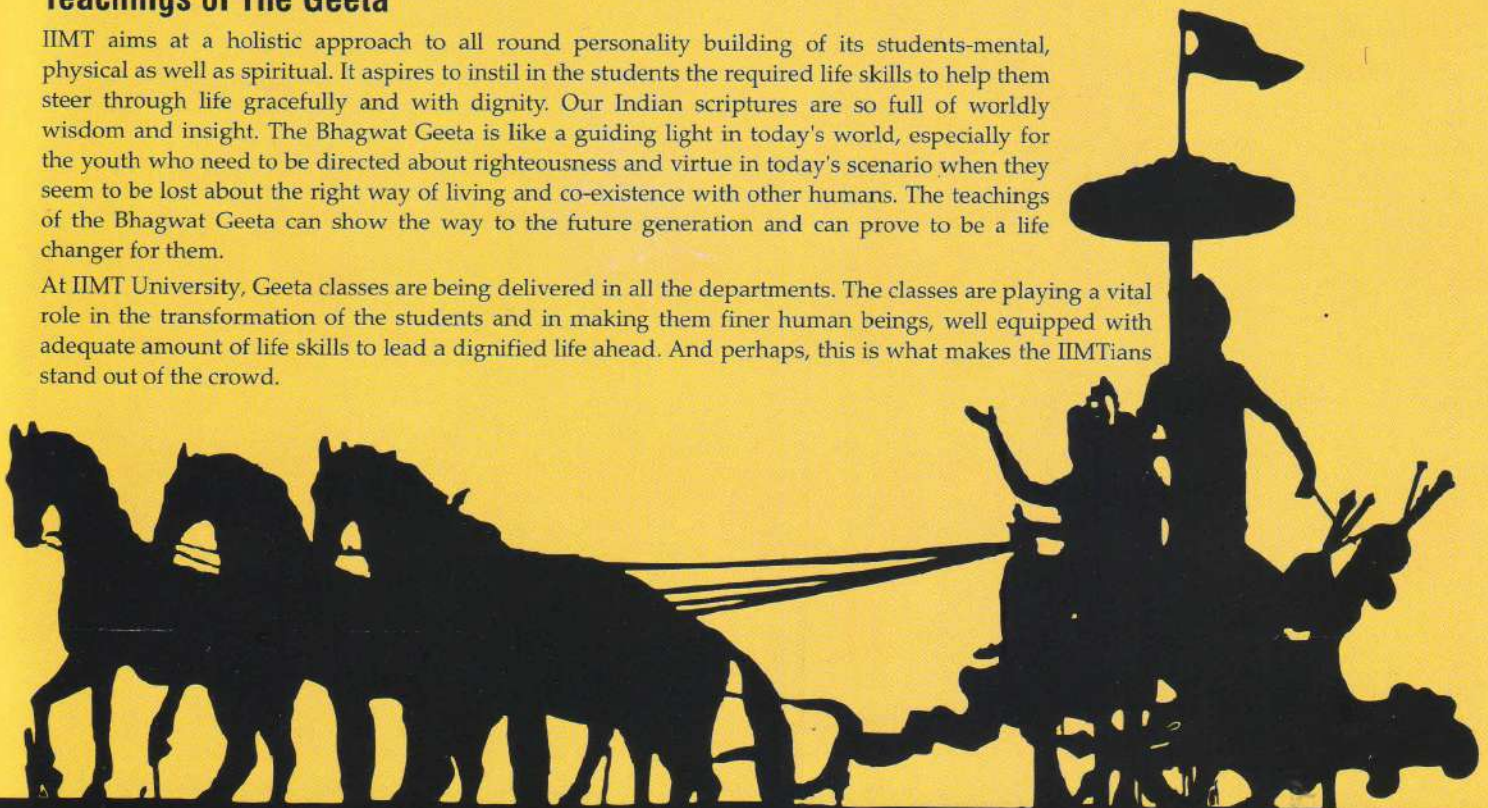

◆ A number of camps have been conducted by the doctors of Lifeline Hospital to facilitate patients in the rural and underprivileged areas.

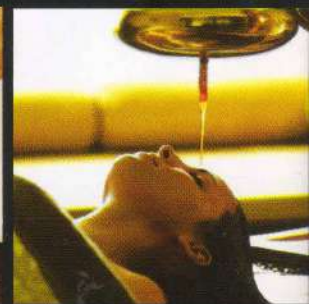
◆ It conducted a CME on the latest techniques in medical science, which was attended by more than 50 doctors.

# SERVICE — To The — NATION Thal Sena NCC Camp

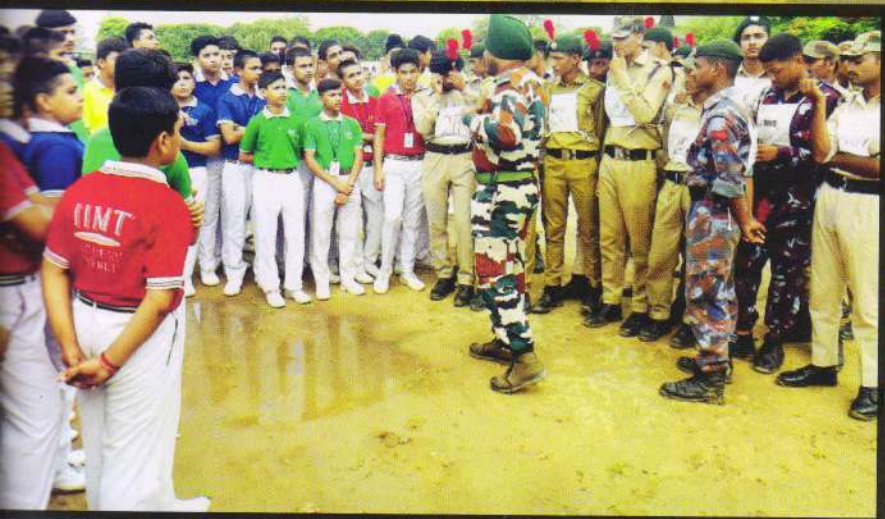
July 3, 2019 onwards

## Sports Initiatives

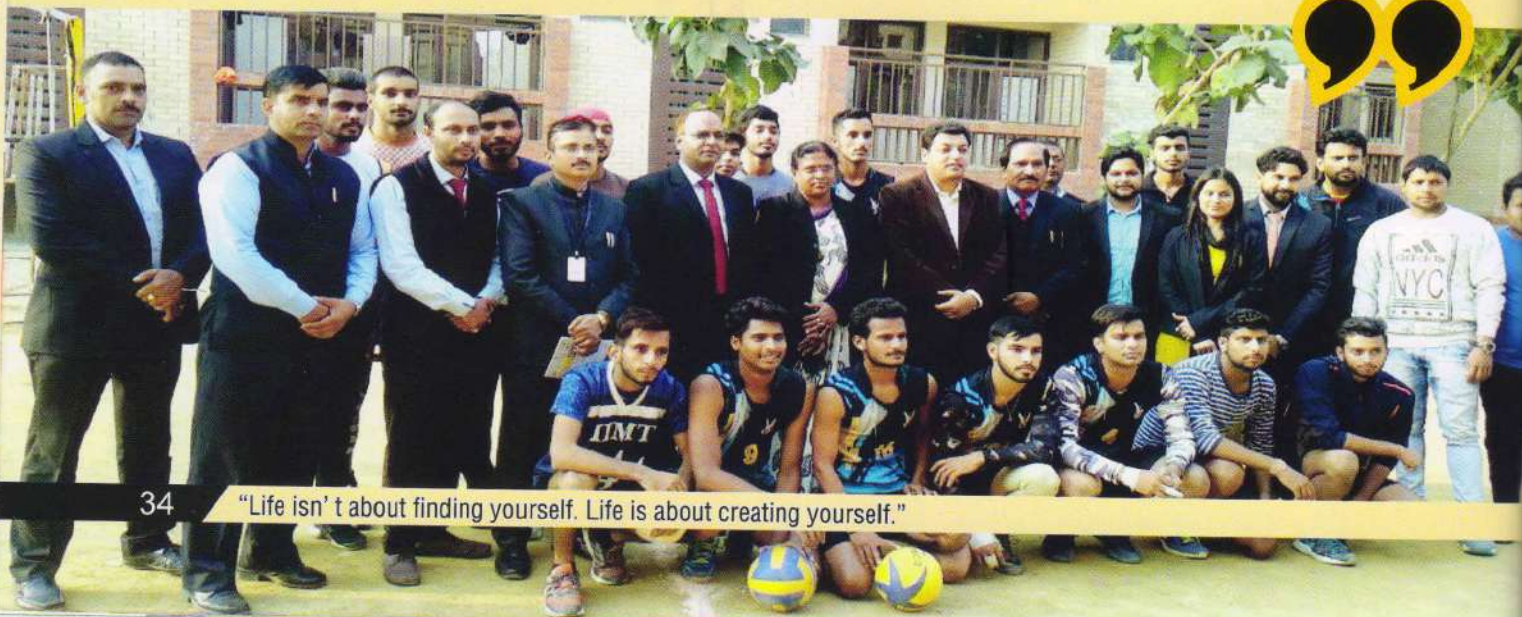

Honourable Vice Chancellor Sir awarded the achievers with medals and certificates.



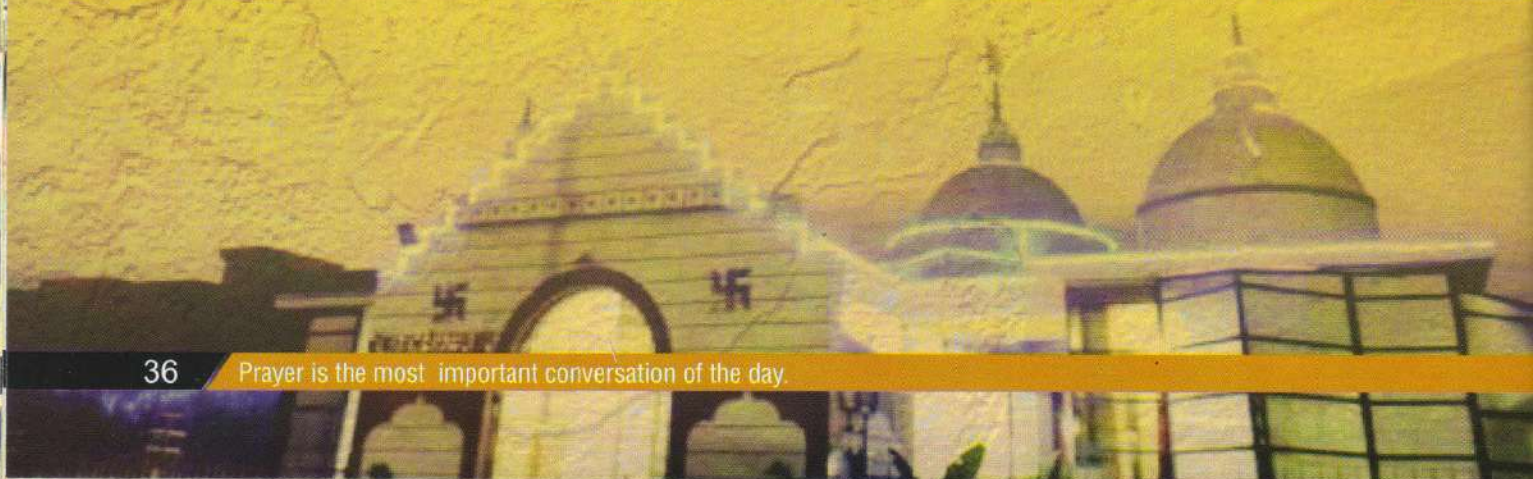
