IIMT University is registered with **SWAYAM** by MHRD, Govt. of India. IIMT University through SWAYSM seeks to bridge the digital drive for students. **E - YANTRA** is an initiative by IIT Bombay that aims to create the next generation of embedded system engineers with a practical outlook. IIT Bombay takes the E – YANTRA platform to harness the intellectual talent of young India to create utility based robotic applications for usage across variety of applications such as: agriculture, manufacturing, home, city maintenance and services industries. IIMT University has tied up with **spoken tutorial projects**. IIMT University has been approved as nodal centre of **ISRO - IIRS OUTREACH PROGRAMME**. An online certified programme of Indian Space Research Organization, (ISRO). #### **QUALITY ASSESSMENT AND ENHANCEMENT / IQAC UPDATES**

For the purpose of Quality assessment and enhancement the IQAC cell in 2020-2021 conducted its meeting on 5.11.2021. The IQAC has revised its policy document guidelines suggested by NAAC. The IQAC coordinator attended online webinar conducted by NAAC to get Better understanding of key indicators and metrics for the hassle free preparation of SSR for the NAAC accreditation on "27 May 2021". On the basis of feedback given by IQAC cell from time to time a research & promotion policy was issued on 29.01.2021 by Registrar office to promote R&D activities. The IQAC has collected AAA (Academic & Administration Audit) report from various school/ colleges and analysis was carried out. On 25 May 2021 Feedback was obtained from 160 faculties working in IIMT University, 160 responses were received and the report has been prepared. On 23th May 2021 feedback was obtained from 1682 parents of students studying in IIMT University.

#### **IIMT - Business Incubator Foundation, MEERUT**

IIMT University has set up two Business Incubators, <u>IIMTU-BI</u> is approved by Govt. of India, Ministry of MHRD, MSME and IIMT-Business Incubator Foundation (registered under section 8 of Company Act 2013, a non-profitable entity for the promotion of research, innovation, incubation and start-ups) with on-campus pre-incubation and incubation facilities in the areas in which the expertise is available to guide the students and budding entrepreneurs.

- Technically supported by PUM with the association of a senior international expert, Dr. Maud Van Den Meiracker from Netherland, who trains the staff of Business Incubator often by visiting the BI for regular upgradation leading it towards a successful BI stepwise.
- 2. BI IIMTU is already in association with TBI-IIT (Ropar) for technology transfer and technical guidance.

#### **Self-Energy Generating Campus (SOLAR Campus)**

The IIMT University knowns the importance of renewable energy sources and thus it has taken a great move to establish a 600 kilo watt solar plant on the rooftop of the Campus, thus generating clean energy.

#### **Solid Waste Management Using Organic Composter:**

IIMT University manages the solid waste, generated within the Campus, into valuable compost. We have developed a machine that will be converts the organic waste like agricultural, garden and kitchen and mess waste into organic compost that can be used for gardening purposes, thereby reducing the use of synthetic fertilizers in gardening purposes.

#### Solar Tree :

Solar Trees are intended to bring visibility to solar technology and to enhance the landscape and architecture they complement, usually in a commercial or public context. An objective of many solar tree installations is to promote awareness, understanding, and adoption of renewable energy. They are not typically sued as a primary source of energy for a property that role is accomplished by rooftop solar systems. Solar trees are complementary to rooftop solar systems, or other green building measures, symbolizing these larger investments and their environmental benefit. 

# TEACHING LEARNING / CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT TOTAL PROGRAMMES WITH CURRENT STUDENT AND FACULTY STRENGTH

During the session 20-21 a total of 60 programmes were conducted. The total students and intake capacity are given programme wise in table 1 in annexure. ## **TEACHING LEARNING / CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT**

#### TOTAL PROGRAMMES WITH CURRENT STUDENT AND FACULTY STRENGTH

During the session 19-20 a total of 60 programmes were conducted. The total students and faculty strength are given programme wise in table 1 in annexure. It seems to be only a matter of yesterday when we laid the foundation of our newly found University and today we see the seed flourishing into a full-fledged blossoming tree.

The brief introduction of the University is as -

IIMT University is a State Private University of Uttar Pradesh established by Govt. of Uttar Pradesh, India vide U.P. Act no. 32 of 2016, with the legacy of group of colleges since 1995 which are now brought under the aegis of IIMT University since 2016 to meet the ever growing needs of higher and professional education.

We are happy to announce that we have almost all the professional courses running under one roof.

IIMT-U objectives include turning innovations into Enterprises, to increase the successful development of new businesses, job creation and employment in specific sectors that are aligned with a region's unique areas of opportunity.

We believe in serving the mission of the Government of creating Entrepreneurs, based on an action plan aimed at promoting guidance, training and financing for **start-up** ventures to boost entrepreneurship and encourage start-ups with jobs creation.

## RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

The University is awarding the doctorate degree in Science, Life Sciences, Engineering & Technology, Education and Physical Education, Law, Management & Commerce and Pharmacy. We are running with second batch of Ph.D.

The Research and Development department of the University has patented some ideas which are incubated at the department only and are in the process of commercialization.

As already evident to all, IIMT University has two Business incubators of MSME, at Engineering & Technology block and at Pharmacy block. There were ten ideas which were funded by MSME for incubation, presently, the cell is waiting for some new schemes to come. The cell has also applied for TBI at Govt. of India.

IIMT University has registered its first startup "Star Technologies" from U.P. recognized by DIPP, Govt. of India which is providing effective solutions that help organizations to improve management efficiencies. This Startup unit of IIMTU is managed by the Alumni of IIMT itself. This company has made number of products by which the unit has made a business of Rs. 1.8 millions in last 8 months by installing / selling their products at different Govt. organizations & private entities.

The product of the company/unit are available on Amazon for sale globally.

Further, IIMT-U, RnD Cell, in its initial year of existence has filed three patents -

- 1. Lineman life saving system
- 2. Sanjeevani driplevel indicator
- 3. Corrugated paper from corn husk.

Our cell incubates the innovative idea, provides necessary facilities & infrastructure during the incubation period till it emerges out as commercializable products.

Keeping in view the requirements of the industry, University has number of tie ups/MoU signed with the intension to make students trained as per the demand of the industry not only this, the syllabi of certain UG & PG courses of commerce, management, computer sciences & applications, Engineering, law, HM etc. are modified to the extent to figure out the idea on reality grounds.

# SUCCESS STORIES OF HMT-U BUSINESS INCUBATOR / R N D CELL/ STAR TECHNOLOGIES:

- 1. Sanjeevani Drip level Indicating device, is filed for patent, Grant & commercialized in different hospitals, the use of product was demonstrated at IIMT Lifeline Hospital itself. The device is used for continuous monitoring of the drip level and raises an alarm upon reaching a pre determined value so that it can be changed in time preventing the backflow of blood into drip bottle.
- 2. Packaging paper made from corn husk which is an agricultural waste and we have extracted best from the waste by inventing a technique which has the potential to reduce deforestation for manufacturing packaging paper. The project has been filed for patent grant.
- 3. Device for UP Power Corporation Ltd. to save the life of lineman while working on energized line.
- 4. Economic Composters is one of project of the students in the areas of Solid Waste Management.
- 5. Solar Tree with the facility of light illusion, wi-fi is made within IIMT and also installed here only.
- 6. RFID and Biometric based Smart Attendance system has been successfully implemented in the university campus.

## ELECTROPRENEUR PARK

An initiative of Ministry of IT and Electronics, Electropreneur Park has been set up to carry out incubation and building ecosystem to help budding entrepreneurs. Entrepreneur park has been set up under the aegis of the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, Software Technology park of India and India Electronics and Semiconductor Association to support startups in electronic system design and manufacturing.

Recently, in Feb. 2019, STAR TECHNOLOGIES (A START UP UNIT OF IIMTU) has submitted two projects out of which one project, the patented idea of RnD Cell, LINEMAN LIFE SAVING SYSTEM is selected among the TOP 10 IDEAS to get incubation and complete hand holding support i.e. funding for commercialization.

Recently, two days back, the result of SMART INDIA HACKATHON 2019, is declared, in which the idea of one engg. Second year student, sujeet kumar Yadav from Nepal is selected for incubation and hand holding support.

## **LIMT UNIVERSITY ANDROID DEVELOPMENT CELL**

IIMT University and Tech Giant Google have signed a Memorandum of understanding (MoU) regarding new courses that offer specialization in Android programming. For this, IIMT has establish a 'Center of Excellence of Google' at its Campus. Under this collaboration, IIMT students will be trained to get Android certifications.

"Now- a- days, more and more people are using smart phones and most of these phones are powered by Android. As such, each and every company is looking to recruit students who are expert in Android programming. This historical tie up will strengthen IIMT students' abilities to meet global challenges of industry ready manpower."

We have introduced a syllabus for ANDROID DEVELOPMENT made by Google as a part from basic to advance at different levels / semesters of Engg., computer applications & Computer Sciences.

Google has trained our 13 faculty under "Train the trainer" scheme for Android Development Fundamentals and 03 faculty /Research Ssholars for advance ANDROID DEVELOPMENT.

Recently they have sent a proposal to attend most advance course of android at California.

IIMT University is registered with National Academic Depositary by MHRD, Govt. of India for the authentication of degrees and marks sheet.

### NPTEL

IIMT University in collaboration with IITs to be able to provide an online certification course from NPTEL and get a certificate from the IITs. IITs are reaching out and taking education to the homes of people through this initiative.

Certified Courses of NPTEL by MHRD, Govt. of India, are integrated in the syllabus.

## **Under Community Social Responsibility**

<u>IIMT University Meerut, Nodal Centre for Swachh Bharat Abhiyan made by MHRD</u>, has taken some great initiatives towards making its campus a green and clean campus supporting the campaign of our honourable prime minister towards Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan.

Following initiatives have been taken in the IIMT University towards the Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan:-

- Self energy generating campus (SOLAR Campus)—IIMT University knows the importance of renewable energy sources and thus it has taken a great move to establish a 600 kilo watt solar plant on the rooftop of the campus, thus generating clean energy.
- 2. Solid Waste Management using organic composter- IIMT University manages the solid waste generated within the campus into valuable compost. We have developed a machine that will be converts the organic waste like agricultural, garden and kitchen and mess waste into organic compost that can be used for

gardening purposes, thereby reducing the use of synthetic fertilizers in gardening purposes.

3. Solar tree - Solar trees are intended to bring visibility to solar technology and to enhance the landscape and architecture they complement, usually in a commercial or public context. An objective of many solar tree installations is to promote awareness, understanding, and adoption of renewable energy. They are not typically used as a primary source of energy for a property—that role is accomplished by rooftop solar systems. Solar trees are complementary to rooftop solar systems, or other green building measures, symbolizing these larger investments and their environmental benefit.

Solar trees may build awareness and interest in solar technology and also provide shade and meeting places.

4. <u>Sewage treatment plant</u> — The university is concerned about water scarcity in the coming future so it has developed an alternative to purify the sewage water so that it can be used as potable water for various purposes like agriculture / gardening, washing etc, thus reducing the wastage of fresh water.
