A keepsake was given to the visitor at the closing remarks. **Dr. Pooja Sharma-Alumni Head** offered the vote of thanks speech.



• Cancer is the **second-leading cause of death** worldwide.**10 million** people die from cancer every year. More than 40% of cancer-related death could be preventable as they are **linked to modifiable risk factors** such as smoking, alcohol use, poor diet and physical inactivity. **Almost at least one third** of all deaths related to cancer could be prevented through routine screening, and early detection and treatment. **70%** of cancer deaths occur in low-to-middle income countries. **Millions of lives** could be saved each year by implementing resource appropriate strategies for prevention, early detection and treatment. ICAR-Central Potato Research Institute Regional Station, Modipuram Campus is the biggest Research Station of the Central Potato Research Institute, Shimla. It has three units, i.e. Modipuram, Machhri and Pabli. At Modipuram main complex, potato research in various disciplines through 15 interdisciplinary programmes is carried out for Central-Indo Gangetic plains. The Machhri and Pabli units are used exclusively for seed production. Besides research and seed production programme of potato, this Campus also serves as one of the centres of All India Co-ordinated Research Project on Potato. Wheat seed production is also carried out in the rotational areas for National Seeds Corporation Ltd. Research work is being carried out by 16 scientists in six disciplines. They are supported by 39 technical and 25 supporting staff. Besides, there are 11 administrative personnel headed by two Assistant Administrative Officers. A four storied building at Modipuram houses laboratories, library, museum and a small meeting hall. The laboratories are well equipped. The administrative block comprises of two single storey buildings which accommodate the office of the Joint Director and the administrative wing.



The history of the station has links with the establishment of Potato Experimental and Trial centre at Babugarh, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh in 1957 and seed production farm at Macchri near Daurala (Meerut) in 1971. Subsequently, a potato research cum seed production unit was established at Modipuram (Meerut) in 1977 simultaneously Babugarh station was closed. In 1978, both Modipuram and Daurala units were amalgamated and the station was renamed as Central

Potato Research Station, Modipuram in 1979. In 1999, the station was upgraded and renowned as Central Potato Research Institute Campus, Modipuram. It is situated at 8 KM from Begum Bridge, Meerut City, on Western side of Meerut-Roorkee Road (NH-58). The Latitude and Longitude of the campus are 29.10 N and 77.920 E respectively. It altitude is 300 meter above Mean Sea Level (amsl). It has 151.74 ha farm for seed production and research activities, while 15.41 ha is constructed building area. Out of this, 22 ha are used for conducting field experiments and the remaining area is utilized for seed production of potato and wheat crops. The Campus is having I6-room Guest Housecum-Hostel with a dining hall and a meeting room for meeting the requirements of visiting officials and trainees. A seven room building Machhri is serving as field lab-cum-stores for the seed production



The ICAR-Central Institute for Research on Cattle (ICAR-CIRC), in Meerut Cantt., is an institute operating under Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Department of Agricultural Research & Education (DARE), Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India. The Central Institute for Research on Cattle (CIRC) formerly known as Project Directorate on Cattle (PDC) was established on 3rd November 1987 at Military Farms School and Research Centre, Meerut by upgrading the status of All- India Coordinated Research Project (AICRP) on Cattle. Being a premiere Institute solely working on the genetic improvement of cattle, it plays significant and pivotal role in improving the cattle production. The ICAR- CIRC conducts interdisciplinary research in the field of cattle breeding, feeding, management and reproduction to enhance productivity and profitability. The Institute plans, coordinates and monitors the research projects on cattle and serves as national data repository and provide consultancy for cattle production and reproduction. The institute plays a significant role by providing superior male germplasm to stakeholders. The Institute helps to produce high producing cattle through the supply of superior progeny tested male germplasm. The production performance of daughters born out of the semen doses supplied by the Institute is comparatively better than the female cattle in other similar programmes. The Institute provides training to the AI workers and farmers involved in cattle rearing and thereby motivate the rural youths and to generate self-employment. The institute also coordinates three important genetic improvement projects through AICRP on cattle to increase the performance of cattle maintained under both farm and field conditions along with suitable technologies for sustenance of production and reproduction. The institute also acts as a key player in the socio-economic upliftment of cattle owners by infusing superior germplasm in the farmer's herd with suitable feeding and management technologies for enhancing the milk production and optimising reproduction.



A honey bee (also spelled honeybee) is a eusocialflying insect within the genus Apis of the beeclade, all native to mainland Afro-Eurasia. After bees spread naturally throughout Africa and Eurasia, humans became responsible for the current cosmopolitan distribution of honey bees, introducing multiple subspecies into South America (early 16th century), North America (early 17th century), and Australia (early 19th century). Honey bees are known for their construction of perennial colonial nests from wax, the large size of their colonies, and surplus production and storage of honey, distinguishing their hives as a prized foraging target of many animals, including honey badgers, bears and human hunter-gatherers. Only eight surviving species of honey bee are recognized, with a total of 43 subspecies, though historically 7 to 11 species are recognized. Honey bees represent only a small fraction of the roughly 20,000 known species of bees. The best known honey bee is the western honey bee, (Apismellifera), which was domesticated for honey production and crop pollination. The only other domesticated bee is the eastern honey bee (Apiscerana), which occurs in South, Southeast, and East Asia. Only members of the genus *Apis* are true honey bees, but some other types of bees produce and store honey, and have been kept by humans for that purpose, including the stingless bees belonging to the genus Melipona and the Indian stingless or dammar bee Tetragonulairidipennis. Modern humans also use beeswax in making candles, soap, lip balms and various cosmetics, as a lubricant and in mould-making using the lost wax process.


