### Formation of student Council

The representative body so selected shall only comprise of regular students on the rolls of the institution. One council member from every school/college is to be nominated by the Dean. The Dean may discuss on the probable names to be nominated among senior faculty members of the school and then unanimously one name is to be selected and sent to Dean Student Welfare.

Dean Student welfare will take final approval from the Hon'le Vice Chancellor.

### Objective

1. To be the voice of the students to the administration and vice versa as well.
2. The purpose of the student council is to give students an opportunity to develop leadership by organizing and carrying out school activities and service projects.
3. Create an environment where every student can voice out their concern or need
4. To provide a platform where the students can showcase their talent without hesitation
5. The student council is responsible for the fluid and graceful functioning of Student and College organized events..

### Tenure of Student Council

The tenure of student council will be one year

### Eligibility Criteria for Selection/Nomination:

The student should be aged between 17 and 22. This age range may be appropriately relaxed in the case of professional colleges, where courses often range between 4 to 5 years.

- I. For Post Graduate Students the maximum age limit would be 24 - 25 years.
- II. For research Students the maximum age limit would be 28 years.
- III. The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the programme / school or 75% attendance, whichever is higher.
- IV. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record; (s) he should not have been

- V. Put on trial/ convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanor. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the University authorities (An affidavit in this regard is to be submitted by the student). The candidate must be a regular, full time student of the University.
- VI. The candidate should not have any academic arrear (Back).
- VII. NOC from concerned Dean/Head (Character Certificate) to be submitted.

### **Removal from student council membership**

If any council member could not maintain the stature of above explained eligibility criterias, his name will be removed from the council.
