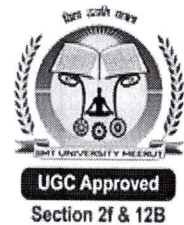

1.2 VISION

We envision an admissions process that transcends conventional boundaries, embracing individuals from all walks of life and empowering them to realize their full potential. 1.3 OBJECTIVES

The Admission Policy of IIMT University is guided by the following objectives:

1. **Promoting Meritocracy:** To ensure that admissions are based on the merit and potential of applicants, as reflected in their academic achievements, aptitude, and extracurricular accomplishments.

4. **Enhancing Educational Quality:** To attract and enroll students who demonstrate a commitment to academic excellence, innovation, and lifelong learning, thereby contributing to the overall enhancement of educational quality at IIMT University.
5. **Aligning with Institutional Values:** To align the Admission Policy with the core values and principles of IIMT University, including integrity, professionalism, respect for diversity, and a commitment to social responsibility.

2. Admission Criteria

The admission criteria at IIMT University are designed to identify candidates who demonstrate the potential to thrive academically and contribute meaningfully to our diverse academic community. Our selection process is rigorous yet fair, ensuring that all applicants are evaluated based on a comprehensive set of criteria that encompass academic qualifications, personal achievements, and potential for success.

2.1. Academic Qualifications

(Eligibility Criteria enclosed as Annexure – 2)

- Applicants are required to meet minimum academic standards, which typically include a required or equivalent desirable qualification.
- Academic performance in previous studies, including grades, coursework, and examination results, is carefully assessed to gauge an applicant's preparedness for higher education.
- Specific program requirements may vary, with some programs requiring prerequisite courses or additional qualifications in specific subjects.

2.2. Standardized Test Scores:

- Depending on the program and jurisdiction, applicants may be required to submit standardized test scores such as CUET, MAT, CLAT, CAT, GRE, GMAT, GATE or equivalent exams.

- Test scores provide an additional measure of an applicant's academic abilities and aptitude for the chosen field of study.

2.3. Extra-curricular Activities and Achievements:

- Beyond academic qualifications, we value applicants who demonstrate a commitment to extra-curricular activities, community service, leadership roles, and personal achievements.
- Participation in sports, arts, clubs, volunteer work, internships, competitions, and other activities highlights an applicant's well-roundedness and potential for holistic development.

2.4. Letters of Recommendation:

- Applicants may be required to submit letters of recommendation from teachers, mentors, employers, or other individuals who can attest to their character, abilities, and potential for success.
- These letters provide valuable insights into an applicant's personal qualities, work ethic, and suitability for the chosen program.

2.5. Statement of Purpose or Personal Statement:

- Many programs require applicants to submit a statement of purpose or personal statement, in which they articulate their academic interests, career goals, motivations, and reasons for choosing the program.
- This allows applicants to showcase their writing skills, self-awareness, and alignment with the values and objectives of the university and the chosen program.

2.6. Personal Interview

- Applicants may be invited to participate in an interview as part of the admission process.
- Interviews provide an opportunity for applicants to further demonstrate their suitability for the program and for admissions committees to assess interpersonal skills, communication abilities, and fit with the university community.

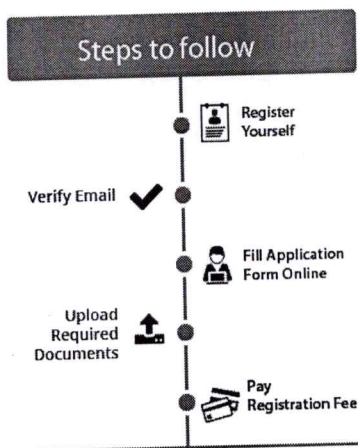
2.7. Special Considerations:

- IIMT University is committed to providing equal opportunities for all applicants, including those with disabilities, special needs, or unique circumstances.
- Special considerations may be made for applicants who have faced adversity, overcome challenges, or demonstrated exceptional talents or achievements.

Our admission criteria are designed to identify individuals who possess the academic qualifications, personal attributes, and potential for success to thrive in our academic community. By evaluating applicants holistically and considering a range of factors, we strive to create a diverse and dynamic student body that enriches the educational experience for all members of our community.

3. Selection Process

Step I: In the initial stage of the application process, prospective candidates are required to register themselves through our Lead Management System, Meritto (formerly known as NPF), providing verified contact information including phone number and email address. Subsequently, candidates proceed to complete an application form, wherein they are prompted to furnish their educational documents along with the requisite registration fee.



Step II: After the successful completion of the first step, the candidate's application undergoes a thorough evaluation process and is critically reviewed by the admissions committee. If the candidate fulfills all the stipulated requirements, a provisional seat is allocated to them.

4. Reservation Policy

In accordance with the guidelines set forth by the University Grants Commission (UGC), IIMT University adheres to a reservation policy aimed at promoting social equity and inclusivity in higher education. Our reservation policy ensures that a percentage of seats in each academic program are reserved for candidates belonging to specific categories, including Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), and Persons with Disabilities (PWD). The reservation percentages are determined by government regulations and may vary depending on the jurisdiction. Candidates seeking admission under reserved categories must provide valid documentary evidence of their eligibility during the application process. Our university remains committed to upholding the principles of fairness and equal opportunity, and our reservation policy reflects our dedication to fostering a diverse and representative student body reflective of the broader societal fabric.

5. Fee Structure and Financial Assistance

In line with our commitment to accessibility and inclusivity, IIMT University maintains a transparent and equitable fee structure designed to facilitate diverse student enrollment.
